BIOGRAPHY

(1) Buck Brooksbank's appointment as the immediate past Chief Executive Officer of the CAA & Airservices Australia follows a 28 year career as an airline pilot with TAA & then Australian Airlines and President of the Australian Federation of Air Pilots in (1) the industrially stable period of the 3 years prior to 1998.

His 10,000 hours of flying experience includes DC3s, B727 and A300 aircraft on (2) domestic and international operations.

He was the inaugural Chairman of the Australian Aviation Advisory Committee from 1989 to 1991 when he took up as the General Manager of Air Traffic operations (3).

(4) He is now a Director for Development and Operational Support of International Airline Crewing, a company providing over 150 air crews to 8 international airlines, primarily wide body aircraft.

(5) IAC GPS has received the Delegation from CASA to design and produce GPS Non Precision Approaches for any airport in Australia. IAC GPS is the first non Government organisation in the Southern Hemisphere to receive such a Delegation and this wholly owned Australian operation is a world leader.
