

Dr ROB LEE - BIOGRAPHY

Dr Rob Lee is the Director of the Australian Bureau of Air Safety Investigation (BASI).

Dr Lee graduated from the Australian National University in 1970 with First Class Honours in Psychology. In 1974 he completed his PhD in Psychology at the University of St Andrews, Scotland.

Rob joined BASI in 1983 as the first Chief of the Human Performance and Research Branch. He was appointed Director of BASI in 1989. Before joining the Bureau, Dr Lee was Senior Psychologist in the Royal Australian Air Force (RAAF) Operational Command.

Dr Lee is a Group Captain in the Medical Branch of the RAAF Specialist Reserve. He is a member of the European Association of Aviation Psychology, the Aviation Medical Society and the International Society of Air Safety Investigators. In 1989 he won the Henry Wigram Award of the New Zealand Division of the Royal Aeronautical Society.

Dr Lee is co-author of the book "Beyond Aviation Human Factors" published in 1995.
